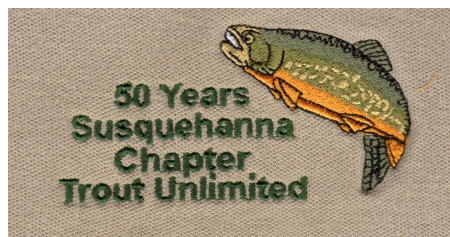

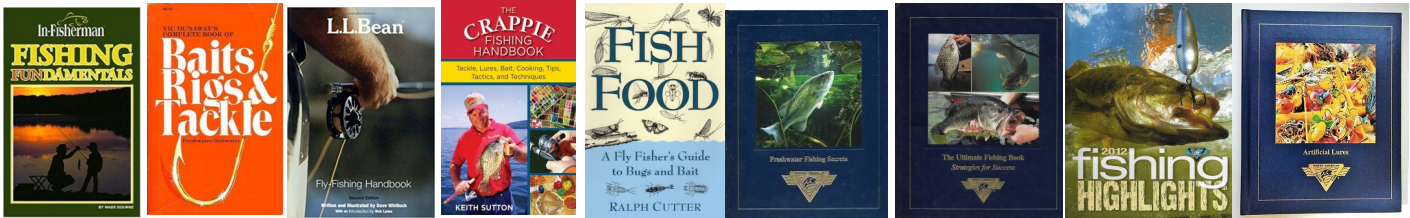

- We can provide special pricing to you if you are purchasing bulk items or a large quantity of items.

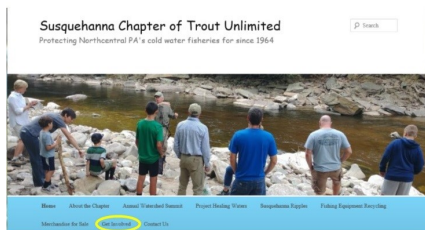
Mailing of items
