What does the Susquehanna Chapter do?

- Annual fly tying class in February
- Developed a Coldwater Heritage Plan for the Rock Run watershed, a tributary of Lycoming Creek. This Plan identified a number of potential activities and projects to maintain and improve the water quality of Rock Run.
- Actively participate with the Girl and Boy Scouts in their recruitment activities and in teaching fishing skills
- Work with the Watershed and Conservation groups to further protect and preserve our waterways
- Is actively working with Lycoming College and Penn College to establish a 5 Rivers College outreach program at each school
- Actively involved in important legislative issues pertaining to the Fish & Boat Commission mission
- Participates in Trout in the Classroom with area schools and help in the release of trout fingerlings each spring
- Currently working with Technical Assistance Grant to identify and correct hazards from acid mine drainage in the Upper Loyalsock Creek Watershed

- Participate in Casting for Recovery - a program for women recovering from breast cancer
- Work with the PA Fish and Boat Commission in the Unassessed Waters Program
- Water Quality monitoring of area streams
- Monitor Gas well development and their impact on streams
- Participate in Field Days with area schools
- An active Service Partnership Program for veterans, first responders and health care workers.
- Built handicap fishing platform at Trout Run Park
- Assist National Trout Unlimited with Field Surveys
- Assist PhD candidate students with their research in area waterways
